Please check the latest versions at these locations and at the competition to ensure you have the correct and most recent performance time. Last minute withdrawals can change the schedule significantly which results in the event often running up to 15 minutes early.

Spectator Tickets

Tickets will be available on the day.

Credit card facilities will be available; however, this may take longer to purchase tickets upon arrival.

Spectator seating

Spectators may be requested to wait patiently at the door until the current routine has finished before entering the auditorium to ensure no interruption to the performance. Upon entry, please locate seating quickly.

ENTRY

All spectators, athletes and coaches must register at the main entry and sign in.

Doors will open for **athletes and coaches at 8.30am.**

Doors will open at **9.00am for spectators.**

Once coaches have registered, they need to exit the foyer and enter the warm up stadium located near the car park.

Covid Safe rules will be in place on the day and Aeroactive suggest the following:

- ensure physical distancing (1.5 metres)
- wear a face mask
- practice good hygiene
- avoid interactions in close spaces
- keep good records and act quickly if staff / patrons become unwell
- Each attendee is asked to do a [symptom self-assessment prior](#) to leaving home and not attend if they are unwell or have been instructed to isolate or quarantine.

Parking

There is free parking available inside the school or in surrounding streets.

Food and Beverages

A coffee cart will be available for drinks and snacks.

Waverley Garden Shopping Centre is also a 5 minute drive from the competition venue.

Video Recording

Cameras are strictly prohibited unless you are recording your own child. **No recording** can occur in the warm up areas. If you plan to record your child, you must do this in the designated area at the front of the competition next to the judges.

Awards

All participants will receive an Aerochallenge participation medallion and carry bag. The top 5 place getters in each category will receive Aerochallenge certificates.

Arrival

It is suggested athletes arrive 45 to 60 minutes prior to the performance time. Please check to see if the competition is running on time, and warm up accordingly.

Athlete viewing

All athletes must exit the stage via the side stage curtains. Athletes may watch the competition from the side stage.

COACHES AND TEACHERS

Withdrawals

Please email through all withdrawals and team changes up until **Friday 16 June 12pm**. If a team member is sick or injured the team can still perform however may only be judged as a demonstration, if their team size does not meet the section requirements (for example a trio performing as a pair). Any requests or special considerations on the day must be in writing and handed to the competition director (Kerryn Cormick) and approved by the head judge.

Warm up area / basketball stadium

Only athletes and coaches are allowed in the warm up area during any part of the competition. To ensure the day runs smoothly please allocate a section where your club/school will warm up. Competition marshals will then be able to identify your school if they need to find the next team. We ask that you leave your area clean and tidy and place ALL RUBBISH in the bin on your departure.

Ready for stage

All coaches are responsible for making sure their team is next to the stage ready to compete 15 minutes prior to the allocated performance time. If you miss your performance time, it is not guaranteed you will be able to perform later in the event.

Results

There will be 3 sessions with the announcement of results at the conclusion of each session. Results will also be sent via email to coaches by Monday 19 June. Alternatively, you can check www.aeroactive.com.au or facebook.

PLEASE collect your score sheets at the end of the session from the judge's table. This feedback will help with State Championships preparation.
